We think all the skills in PSED and C+L are important and so teach them all the time through continuous provision and specific teaching when an opportunity arises.

Understanding the World:

- Recognise some environments that are different Denton by comparing London and Denton.
- To draw information from a simple map.
- To make simple links with other places.
- To learn about figures from the past e.g.
 Guy Fawkes, Queen Elizabeth II
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways e.g. Christmas, Diwali and join in with family customs and events (Bonfire night and Christmas).
- To develop a sense of wonder and curiosity about London.
- Explore sinking and floating.
- To comment on images of familiar situations in the past.

Physical Development:
